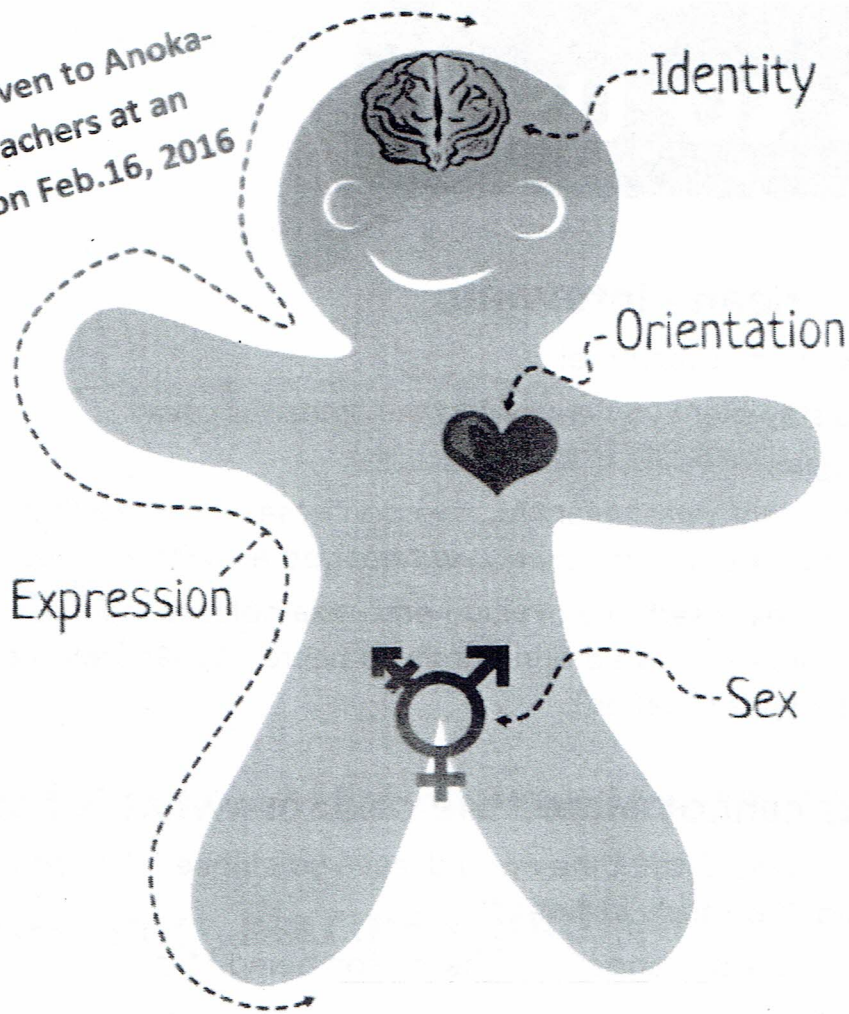


These handouts were given to Anoka-Hennepin District 11 teachers at an anti-bullying training on Feb.16, 2016



Gender identity refers to a person's internal sense of being male, female, or something else.



Gender expression refers to the way a person communicates gender identity to others through behavior, clothing, hairstyle, voice or body characteristics.



Sex is assigned at birth and refers to one's biological status as either male or female.



Sexual orientation refers to the sex of those to whom one is sexually and romantically attracted.



Gender refers to the socially constructed roles, behaviors, activities, and attributes that a given society considers appropriate for boys and men or girls and women.
